GRANT GUIDELINES

- Project must be specific to providing screening and diagnostic services to uninsured or underinsured women in financial need who reside in Indiana.
- Funding limits on programming requests apply. See application for details.
- Organizations may only apply for one (1) grant of each type per grant cycle per facility location.
- Reimbursement rates are based on current Medicare reimbursement rates. See the application for details.
- Applicants must be a U.S. nonprofit (federally tax-exempt) organization.
- Services are to be within the State of Indiana and for Indiana residents only.
- A grant contract will be the legal mechanism for funding of grant.
- Announcement of awards will be made no later than December 15, 2023.
- Grantees will submit quarterly financial reports along with a six-month progress report and final grant report to IBCAT.
- Grant funding for this project will begin January 1, 2024 and end December 31, 2024.
- Grant Applications must be <u>delivered</u> to our post office box via the US Postal Service <u>no later</u> than <u>Friday, September 22, 2023</u>.
- An electronic copy must be submitted to <u>info@breastcancerplate.org</u> no later than <u>6:00 pm CST</u>, <u>Thursday</u>, <u>September 21</u>, <u>2023</u>.
